How We Began

In the early morning mist of April 7, 1788, a group of 48 pioneers arrived at the mouth of the Muskingum River in a flatboat and three canoes. Led by General Rufus Putnam, the Ohio Company came ashore and thus began the first organized settlement of the Northwest Territory. Here at the confluence of the Ohio and Muskingum Rivers, these American Revolutionary War veterans built a community that opened the door west of our nation's expansion and growth. By year-end the population was 137 with the arrival of the settlers' families. The settlers named the town Marietta in honor of Marie Antoinette, the Queen of France, whose government had supported the Americans in the Revolutionary War.

George Washington wrote, "No colony in America was ever settled under such favorable auspices as that which has just commenced at the Muskingum. If I was a young man, just preparing to begin the world or if advanced in life and had a family to make provision for, I know of no country where I should fix my habitation."

The broad waters of the Ohio provided transportation for commerce and trade, while the forests and fertile lands supported the lumber and farming business. Shipbuilding was a thriving industry with full-rigged ocean-going vessels leaving for ports all around the world. Marietta was truly a river-boat town and by 1803, Ohio had enough inhabitants to become the 17th state in the United States.

In 1860, oil was first drilled in the Marietta region. The immense wealth from the oil and gas industries resulted in the many magnificent homes still gracing our downtown historic district. Manufacturing became a dominant economic driver in the mid-1900's. Suburbs developed, schools were built, and the completion of Interstate 77 ensured that Marietta remained connected to the rest of the nation.

Today, Marietta retains much of its historic charm and traditional values, while embracing modern technology to keep Marietta connected to the world.

Things you HAVE to see!

The Historic District - Antique shops and eateries, authentic brick-paved streets, restored historical houses and a levee on which to relax and watch boats on the river.

Campus Martius Museum - Constructed around the original stockade, built in 1788 to serve as the first seat of government outside of the original thirteen colony-states.

Muskingum Park - Features the "Start Westward" monument built for Marietta's sesquicentennial celebration by Gutzon Borglum (the man who later sculpted Mount Rushmore). Presidents F.D. Roosevelt, Theodore Roosevelt and W.H. Taft have spoken here.

Sacra Via - See ceremonial mounds built by the Hopewell culture on this historic street in the heart of Marietta.

Ohio Company Land Office - Built in 1788, it's the oldest existing building west of the Alleghenies and was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1970.

The 'W.P. Snyder - the last of the steam-powered sternwheeled towboats in the US is docked at the Ohio River Museum on the Muskingum River.

Hidden Marietta Tour Company at The Anchorage- Located in Harmar Village, the Anchorage was built and lived in by Douglas Putnam. The Hidden Marietta Tour Company and the Washington County Historical Society now provide both historic and ghost tours of this beautiful villa

Annual Sternwheel Festival - Occurring on the weekend after Labor Day this event is packed full of Sternwheelers, live music, boat races, fireworks and lots of fun!

Mound Cemetery in Marietta - has the most Revolutionary War officers (24) buried in any one United States cemetery.

Harmar Historic District listed on the National Registry of Historic Places where Fort Harmar - one of the few federal forts was built to protect Native Americans from settlers



Always on the Frontier

Marietta and Washington County were the home of lots of beginnings, not just that of Ohio and the American Mid-West. We blazed a trail for the first of many things, including:

- X-ray photograph used in surgery - performed by Dr. John E. Gilman in 1896
- Seat of government in the Northwest Territory
- Bank building in Ohio - "Bank of Marietta"
- School teacher in first permanent school in Ohio Territory - Major Anselm Tupper, 1788
- Use of the term "Buckeye" for Ohioans - Colonel Ebenezer Sproat
- Clerk in first court in Ohio - Return Jonathan Meigs, Jr.
- Postmaster (later the 5th Postmaster General) in Ohio - Return Jonathan Meigs, Jr.
- Library in Ohio - Farmers Library in Belpre, Ohio, in 1796
- Auditor of Ohio - Colonel Thomas Gibson

Famous Mariettans

C. William O'Neill - The only Ohioan to have held the highest offices in all three branches of our state government: speaker of the Ohio House of Representatives, governor of Ohio and Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Ohio.

Charles Dawes - Nobel Prize winner for his successful plan to raise \$200 million for the Allies during WWI, Vice-President under President Calvin Coolidge and Ambassador to England for President Herbert Hoover.

Betsy Mitchell - Olympic gold-medalist swimmer.

Nancy Hollister - First woman to serve as Governor of Ohio and first woman elected Ohio's Lieutenant Governor.

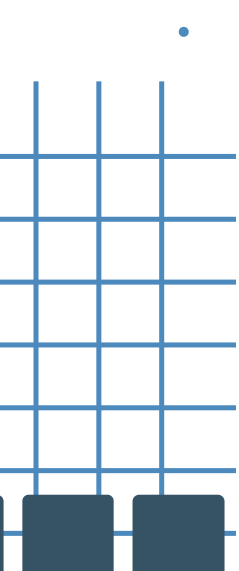

Cost of Living

Washington County offers more than a well-balanced business environment. It's also a safe and comfortable place to live and raise a family. Despite being less than 2 hours from both Pittsburgh and Cincinnati, Washington County maintains shorter commutes with less traffic and fewer stoplights, lower crime rates, safe and high performing schools, plus many other desirable characteristics that equal fewer distractions, more productivity, and more time to enjoy living.

The federal government reports wages at the metropolitan level. Washington County, Ohio, and Wood County, West Virginia, comprise the Parkersburg–Marietta Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA). Sperling's Best Places ranks Washington County's cost of living at 13% less than the national average. Our cost of living indices are based on a US average of 100. An amount below 100 means Washington County, Ohio is cheaper than the US average. A cost of living index above 100 means Washington County is more expensive. Overall, Washington County, Ohio's cost of living is 86.60.

HOW FAR CAN MY DOLLAR GO?

A competitive consumer price index makes Washington County an attractive place to invest and reside. According to Sperling's Best Places, this area scores an 86, with 100 being the national average. That is significantly lower than most major cities in the country.

On average the closest metropolitan area of over 1 million is 44% more expensive than the Mid-Ohio Valley.

Why? Nestled away from the breakneck pace of major metropolitan areas, southeastern Ohio is a place where people come to escape the rigors of big-city life. A movie ticket still costs less than \$10, a gourmet cup of coffee will only run you about \$2, an incredible dinner for two at one of the area's finest restaurants will come in significantly under \$100, hotel rooms range from \$40 to \$165 and a handshake from a local mayor is free.

Education

Whether you are looking to enroll a child in a good school system, register an employee for a technical certification program or earn your Master's Degree, you will find access to high-quality educational resources in Washington County. The graduation rate of Washington County high schools is 92%. Approximately 43.6% of the Washington County population over the age of 25 has attended college.

Washington County is home to six public school districts offering K-12 education, and in the area there are five private/independent/parochial secondary schools.

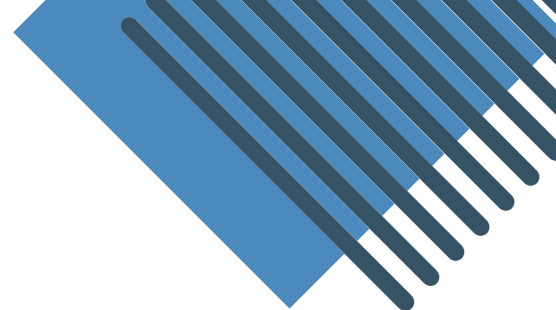

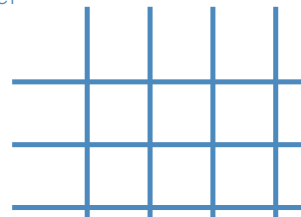
